

SafeCall is a service provided by UK charity Missing People which supports children and young people who have been away from home and exploited by gangs or involved with county lines.

A trained and dedicated telephone advisor can offer a safe space to discuss their experience, explore their options, and help formulate a safety plan.

SafeCall can also be accessed by parents and carers of exploited young people for emotional support, confidential discussions and guidance on keeping family members safe.
